The requested information is not collated by NHS Orkney, therefore I must advise that in terms of Section 17 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 the information sought is not held. <p>All residents who require these services will be referred to NHS Grampian for treatment in Aberdeen. This is at the Eden Unit facility in Aberdeen that NHS Grampian run as a part of the North of Scotland specialist facility. NHS Orkney contribute on a risk share basis to this facility and does not commission a specific number of male or female beds.</p>
