## Dental Charges

There are nationally set charges for all NHS treatment. Payment is required at the time of your treatment, by cash, cheque or credit/debit card. We will provide an estimated total cost of your treatment at your first appointment.

**We do not undertake any private dental treatment.**

## Charge Exemptions

There are exemptions for patients in receipt of some types of benefit, during pregnancy and for a year after your baby is born. Evidence that you are exempt is required at the time of treatment. Unfortunately receipt of the state pension alone does not qualify you for free treatment.
