1. Any and all documents relating to the health board's policy on single-sex/mixed-sex wards. This should include any information on whether there are mixed-sex wards and what these wards are (for example, oncology, stroke units,etc).

2. How many people were treated on mixed-sex wards in the last two years. Could you please break this down by hospital and year.

Response

Please be advised that NHS Orkney is a small remote and rural health board which operates one hospital – the Balfour hospital. The Balfour Hospital operates on a single room basis with the exception of High Dependency Unit (HDU).

- 1. NHS Orkney does not have a policy with regards to mixed sex wards. The Balfour Hospital has one mixed sex ward which is the HDU.
- 2. The requested information is not collated by NHS Orkney, therefore I must advise that in terms of Section 17 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 the information sought is not held.
